



Fellowship Training Program Fees

ASTS continues to devote substantial resources to fellowship training activities such as the Annual Surgical Fellows Symposium, Program Directors Meetings, and accreditation standards. In 2017, ASTS will launch an affiliated Limited Liability Corporation (LLC) titled the Transplant Accreditation & Certification Council (TACC) to oversee accreditation functions and to develop a pathway for fellow certification. As part of this transition, the fees below are in place to ensure sufficient resources to support both programs and fellows.
